Targets are about \$300-\$400 each. Permanent in concrete – 20 years

9 hole course \$3,000 for baskets

Course design: preferred to have DisCap to design the course will be free likely. Often \$500 per day. Safety #1, discs are hard. A well designed course is safe. Use underutilized parts of the park. Need moderate amounts of trees. Through the trees are fine but not a dense forest.
